Gathers data on own behavior and reflects on frequencies and reasons behind the numbers	
Initiates conversations and social interactions appropriately	
Avoids the use of harmful, hurtful, or offensive langue	
Avoids invading others' personal space	
Assumes responsibility for academic tasks	
Assumes responsibility for behaviors and misbehaviors	
Speaks and behaves politely	
Cooperates with others:	
Takes turns in conversations and activities	
Takes the lead or follows others, as appropriate	
Follows directions	
Takes responsibility for the learning and success of group members	
Assists others, and accepts assistance from others, when necessary	
Shares materials and information willingly	
Begins an activity when asked	
Stops an activity when asked	
Acts empathetically, with an awareness of others' feelings:	
Treats peers and adults with kindness	
Calms self (in a timely manner) when incidents occur	
Mentors younger students	
Takes guidance (when positive and productive) from older students	
States kind words to students and adults, particularly when others appear to be "down"
