

Ten-Day Learning Cycle Checklist

The ten-day learning cycle is a plan for planning instruction, assessment, and intervention. The cycle is implemented only for essential standards.

Day	Task	Accomplished
Day one	Unpack essential standards. This process is ongoing.	[Revisit]
Day two	Create common formative assessments.	
Day three	Create a lesson plan using unpacked essential standards.	
Days four–seven	Teach a lesson plan.	
Day eight	Give a formative assessment and analyze that data; create an intervention lesson with differentiated instruction.	
Day nine	From the intervention data, develop intervention groups.	
Day ten	Reassess the <i>didn't get it yet</i> group.
