- Did any of the specific details about this loan support or break our classroom lending priorities?
- Why did your team select this specific country?
- What impact will this loan have on the community or country you are supporting?
- Why did you feel as though this was the best loan to support?
- What are the weaknesses in this loan? Why was it worth moving forward in spite of these weaknesses?
