

Rubric for Assessing Collaborative Work

Criteria	Trying	Striving	Thriving
Listening	Listens to ideas with some interruptions or repeating of ideas	Listens to ideas with nonverbal and verbal acknowledgment (eye contact, body language)	Listens to ideas, paraphrases ideas, and builds and makes connections to ideas
Contributing	Offers a few thoughts to the group	Offers thoughts to the group that are on topic Helps the group achieve its task, product, or dialogue	Puts ideas on the table Makes connections to specific texts, resources, or activities Pushes the group to accomplish a task, product, or dialogue that everyone feels proud of
Questioning	May ask a few questions to clarify	Asks questions to clarify the task or understand another person's ideas	Asks questions to clarify the task and understand another's ideas, especially when they don't agree Asks questions that lead to spirited and meaningful dialogue and ideas
