Plagiarism Alert: Are no more than four words in a row taken from the original text (other than the direct quotation)? What is this author doing well in this piece? What would you like to see more of in this piece? What is one suggestion you have for strengthening this piece of analysis?

Does the microanalysis meet the teacher's length requirement?
