Instructions: Identify a cause from the fishbone diagram that your team feels significantly contributes to the current reality or problem. Then ask yourself, "Why is this happening?" Follow up with actual data or instances, not assumptions. Once it is hard to answer why, you likely have identified the root of the problem.	
Cause identified: Instruction lacks real-world applications of learning, as shown in the fishbone diagram about lack of student engagement.
