

Standard 6: Do and Avoid Chart

After reading the effective and less effective practice examples and reflecting on them and the work of standard 6, complete the following do and avoid chart to help you record your thoughts about the work of this standard.

1. How will you introduce your team to the processes introduced in this chapter?
2. How will you facilitate discussions about how to promote stakeholder collaboration?
3. How will you identify your personal circle of influence and assign roles and responsibilities?
4. How will you identify people outside your personal circle of influence whom you need to support the work?
5. How will you use the influence planner (see figure 6.2, page 123) and the influencers and best approaches for interacting chart (see figure 6.3, page 124) to guide your work?
6. How will you ensure you align actions and foundational commitments?
7. How can you use different types of dialogue to sustain alignment of actions and foundational commitments while supporting communication and engagement?
