2. Narrow and Prioritize

3. Target a Focus	
Ensure that teams do not get overloaded with multiple targets and goals. How can each team have one or two goals that support the school's overall goals?	
4. Engage in Goal Setting	
Developing a coalition of staff members who will champion a cause is essential. When will the key stakeholders come together to establish new goals based on the data?	
5. Monitor Our Progress	
Ensuring an opportunity to make adjustments or refocus is critical. What will be the benchmark dates for communicating the team's progress?
