<p>1. Analyze the Data</p> <p>Think about what the data show. What patterns do you notice? What do the data show? What implications can you draw from the data?</p>	
<p>2. Narrow and Prioritize</p> <p>Given the array of implications, prioritize an area or issue for improvement. What might be most pressing, given the current context? What might be most doable?</p>	
<p>3. Target a Focus</p> <p>Ensure that teams do not get overloaded with multiple targets and goals. How can each team have one or two goals that support the school's overall goals?</p>	
<p>4. Engage in Goal Setting</p> <p>Developing a coalition of staff members who will champion a cause is essential. When will the key stakeholders come together to establish new goals based on the data?</p>	
<p>5. Monitor Our Progress</p> <p>Ensuring an opportunity to make adjustments or refocus is critical. What will be the benchmark dates for communicating the team's progress?</p>
