Team Type	Power Players
Grade-level or content-area team	Co-teachers and teacher aides, ESL teachers, and content specialists
Problem-solving teams	Psychologists, social workers, guidance counselors, ESL teachers, special education teachers, and deans
Vertical alignment teams	Specialists, curriculum experts, special educators, ESL teachers, and department chairs
Intervention teams	Psychologists, specialists, curriculum specialists, special educators, and ESL teachers
Job-alike building and district teams	All ESL teachers, music teachers, specialists, and PE teachers
