Achievement booster	Your ideas for helping students use these with your teaching
<p>Relate the specific study method to the exact subject content. (Specifics work better than generalities.)</p>	
<p>Teach students metacognition skills to self-assess for depth and accuracy.</p>	
<p>Provide students thinking maps (bubble maps, flowcharts, or mind maps).</p>	
<p>When finished, debrief students with the questions, “How did you do that?” and “What can you do better?”</p>	
<p>Attribute student success to effort, attitude, and strategy.</p>	
<p>Practice content retrieval, not just a study review.</p>
