How to Deliver an Effective Presentation

Teach the new knowledge or skills at a fast pace to maintain student attention and in small increments to ensure student understanding.

1.	Identify the major steps you will use for the explanation:
2.	Identify the key points you will use in your explanations of the new learning:
3.	Good exemplars and non-exemplars play an important role in explanations. Identify the exemplars and non-exemplars you will use:
4.	Model the procedures, such as thinking aloud, and use clear and consistent language. Describe how you will model the new learning:
5.	Monitor student understanding by asking questions and providing modified explanations or demonstrations as needed. Identify the major questions you will use to gauge student understanding:
	Identify the alternative explanations or demonstrations you can use if the initial ones are insufficient
6.	Record any reflections:
