## Conventional Model for Unit or Lesson Planning: Hunter Plan Format

<b>Anticipatory Set:</b> Activate prior knowledge to relate to the current lesson.	
Objective or Purpose: Clarify what students should know and be able to do.	
Instructional Input: Provide explanations and demonstrations to impart knowledge to students.	
<b>Model:</b> Demonstrate the skill or competence so students can see what it looks like in action.	
Check for Understanding: Use questions, observations, and other techniques to check student understanding.	
<b>Guided Practice:</b> Implement activities that students perform under your supervision.	
<b>Independent Practice:</b> Implement activities that students perform without your supervision.
