Role	Responsibilities
Facilitator	<p>The facilitator leads the team through task directions, ensures a high quality of work from each member, ensures all voices on the team are heard, supports the exchange of feedback, and resolves conflict.</p> <p><i>Questions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can we pause to review our work before moving on? • Can I hear another idea? • Is there anything we can do to improve our responses?
Motivator	<p>The motivator reflects on how the group process is going and how motivated everyone is feeling, leads reflection of team dynamics, and takes steps to improve team members' feelings of positivity and motivation.</p> <p><i>Questions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How are you (or we) feeling? I appreciate how you (or we) . . . • Is there something you (or we) could do differently that would make this feel better?
Project Manager	<p>The project manager ensures teamwork is completed on time by creating, managing, and adjusting deadlines and assigning tasks to the team; manages materials; and takes notes.</p> <p><i>Questions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do we have what we need? • Do you know what you can be doing?
Advocate	<p>The advocate acts as the team representative to outside parties, including the teacher, other teams, and members of the community, and identifies opportunities to improve outcomes through better use of resources or access to additional resources.</p> <p><i>Questions:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is there anything we have available to us that can answer our questions or help us do even better work? • Is there anything we can request that would help us improve our work?
