

Netbook Glogster Movie Poster Lesson Plan

Content Area: Language Arts

Grade Levels: 3–8

Features and Materials: Netbook with Internet access, chapter book or novel, and Glogster account (edu.glogster.com)

ISTE Standards: Creativity and Innovation (1a, 1b), Research and Information Fluency (3b), Technology Operations and Concepts (6a, 6b)

21st Century Skills: Communication, collaboration, and creating

Activity Overview

In this activity students will summarize a book that they have read by creating a movie poster that advertises the book.

Procedure

1. Before class, open an educator Glogster account at edu.glogster.com. Add students to your account.
2. After students have read their book, have them identify their favorite scene from the book. Tell students that they should use their favorite scene as the main visual for the movie poster.
3. Have students use the text function to write a short summary of the book and quotes from some of the characters.
4. Have students import download photographs, sound files, and video from the internet to include with their poster.

Extension

1. Before class, open an educator Glogster account at edu.glogster.com. Add students to your account.
2. Have students dress up as characters in the book and act out a favorite scene. Students can videotape a short scene and upload it to their movie Glogster.
