Sony PSP Vocabulary Book Lesson Plan

Content Area: All Grade Levels: 3-12

Features and Materials: Sony PSP and PowerPoint

Activity Overview

In this activity, students will create an electronic ABC vocabulary book that focuses on key events, characters, ideas, and information from a unit of study.

Procedure

- 1. Ask students to create a list of words, using the entire alphabet, that relate to the unit of study for each letter (for example, in an astronomy unit, A—asteroid, B—black hole, C—constellation, and so on).
- 2. Ask students to create simple definitions that an elementary student could understand for each term and identify a picture that could be used to accompany the term.
- 3. Ask students to create a PowerPoint that includes twenty-seven slides. The first slide should include a title; the other twenty-six slides will be for the pages of the book (one for each letter of the alphabet).
- 4. Each page of the electronic book should include the vocabulary word, a picture, and an example.
- 5. Once the PowerPoint is completed, ask students to save the PowerPoint as JPEG images. The file can then be transferred to the Sony PSP and shared with other classmates.

Extension

- 1. Ask students to create study cards for units using the same methods.
- 2. Ask students to write short stories using unit vocabulary and share them with classmates.
