Teachers who excel at teaching reasoning use a sequence of questions to develop thinking.

- "Tell me again please, what claim are you making?"
- "What's your evidence for saying that?"
- "Can you connect what (another student) just said to your comments? Do you feel different or the same; do you agree or disagree?"
- "If that happened, what might happen next?"
- "What are probable causes for that?"
- "Why did they do it this way, and can you think of other ways to do it?"
