Suggestions for Getting Started

- 1 Talk with your student's homeroom teacher to receive input about your student.
- 2 Check with the homeroom teacher to arrange a time to meet with your student.
- 3 Allow your student to help you or another student in your classroom/department.
- 4 Upper grade SOS students can read to lower grade students or help with special jobs.
- 5 Remember to give praise for efforts and give encouraging words.

Guidelines for Working With Your Student

- 1 **VERY IMPORTANT: No money, food, or gift items of any kind are to be given or exchanged.**
- 2 You should make two or three contacts with your student each week. The contact can be anytime during the day that is convenient to your schedule.
- 3 Remember your involvement with this student is **confidential**. The student should not have knowledge of your assignment to him or her.
- 4 Check with the student in regard to his or her homework. Do not be afraid to ask to see the student's homework or offer to help him or her with it.
