Reciprocal Teaching and Annotating: Student Group Roles

Predictor: Makes predictions about what will happen next based on what they see, what group members discussed, or what group members have read so far.

Questioner: Asks questions about unclear or confusing parts of the text, lesson, lecture, or discussion The questioner may ask questions to make connections between what the group is learning now and previously taught material. They ask questions to help their group members understand what is happening in the text and to make sure the group isn't missing any important details.

Clarifier: Makes sure the group completely answers all the questioner's questions and all members of the group understand. The clarifier focuses on the confusing parts and makes the unclear pieces clear by elaborating and explaining.

Summarizer: Takes all the information and helps the group members decide which pieces are important and turns all the information into a short summary statement.
