Be sure to note specific places where you'd like to add comments or respond to other viewers. Consider starting your comments with phrases like: *I notice, I wonder, I realized, You can relate this to, Although it seems, This reminds me of, I'm not sure that, and If I were \_\_\_\_\_, I would \_\_\_\_\_.*

1. Do you agree with the general direction that this conversation is heading in? Why or why not? What key points are being left out that you intend to bring to the digital table?
2. What connections can you make between this conversation and content that you've studied in other places and at other times? How can you integrate those connections into this conversation?
3. Which strand of conversation is the most motivating to you? Why? When will you return to see how that strand of conversation is developing?
