



## Collaborative Team Discussion: Using Data

The following is intended for use in a standard forty-five- to fifty-minute collaborative team meeting.

As a team, define the ideal rating (never, seldom, often, or consistently) for each of the following actions involved in using data. Is *consistently* ideal for A, B, and C? Is *often* the best choice? Record your collective team ideal rating for each action of using data. Use the following key: never is zero days, seldom is one to three days, often is four to six days, and consistently is seven to ten days.

Using Data Action	Ideal Rating
A. We use ongoing methods to assess question 4 students' skill levels and design instruction accordingly.	
B. Our collaborative team reviews the quality of common assessments.	
C. Our collaborative team uses data to inform question 4 student programming.	

Why are these the ideal ratings for each action?

How close are each of us to that ideal rating for each action?

How can we help each other get there?

For those of you who rated your actions as *often* or *consistent* on using data, how does it feel for you, the teacher? What feedback do you hear from your students and their parents?
